# Annual Safety Check and Barbecue

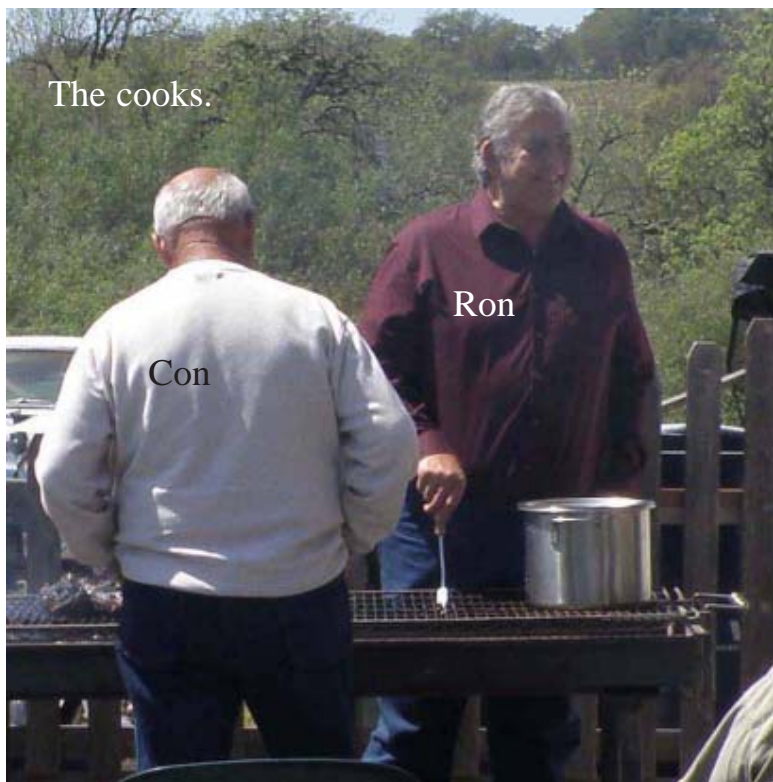

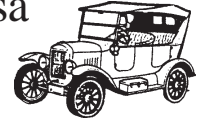


# Garage Sale and Model T Display

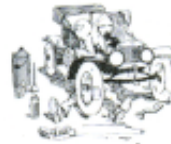
